

## **WARNINGS:**

- AVOID POTENTIAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE, DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN THE SCREWS. TIGHTEN UNTIL THE PLATE IS PRESSED FIRMLY AGAINST THE CEILING.

- ADJUST THE PROJECTOR MOUNT PLATE SO THAT THE CENTER IS ALIGNED WITH THE CENTER OF PROJECTOR AND CEILING MOUNT.
- ENSURE THE CENTER OF THE CEILING MOUNT PLATE IS LOCATED WITHIN THE CIRCLED AREA HIGHLIGHTED ABOVE. KEEPING THE MASS CENTERED ON THE QUICK MOUNT PLATE WILL CREATE A STRONGER MAGNETIC CONNECTION BETWEEN THE PROJECTOR MOUNT AND THE CEILING PLATE.
- ⚠ MAKE SURE THAT THE PROJECTOR ASSEMBLY DOES NOT EXCEED 25LBS (11.3KG)
- MAKE SURE THERE IS NO DEBRIS BETWEEN THE QUICK MOUNT PLATE AND CEILING PLATE. THE MAGNETS MUST BE CLEAN TO ENSURE A STRONG CONNECTION TO CEILING.
- USE CAUTION NOT TO SLIDE THE ASSEMBLY WHEN INSTALLING OR REMOVING FROM CEILING.
  SLIDING CAN CAUSE SCRATCHES OR DAMAGE TO THE CEILING PLATE. SEPARATING ONE SIDE AT A
  TIME USING A DOWNWARD LINEAR FORCE IS THE RECOMMENDED METHOD.
- ⚠ BE SURE TO HAVE A GOOD GRIP ON THE PROJECTOR ASSEMBLY WHEN REMOVING, PULLING FROM THE MOUNT AND NOT THE PROJECTOR.
